

WEATHER NOTIFICATION

Current conditions:

Cloudiness has decrease and shower activity around the Cayman area has ceased. Radar images are now only showing isolated showers within the Cayman area which are rapidly moving towards the northwest. This may result in brief passing showers overnight. This noted improvement is in line with model guidance and gives confidence to improvement expected for tomorrow.

Forecast Conditions:

Tonight: Partly cloudy skies with a 30% chance of showers.

Winds will be southeast to south at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts in and around heavy thunders. Seas will be rough with wave heights of 4 to 6 feet. **Small craft should exercise caution over the open seas.**

Tomorrow: Partly cloudy skies with a 30% chance of showers.

Winds will be southeast to south at 15 to 20 knots. Seas will be rough with wave heights of 4 to 6 feet. **Small craft should exercise caution over the open seas.**
