

## **WEATHER NOTIFICATION**

## **Current conditions:**

Upper-level conditions have become less favorable for the sustainability of moderate to heavy showers as experienced today of Grand Cayman. Radar images are now only showing a patch of scattered, strong to intense thundershowers, just east of Cayman Brac. This patch of showers is rapidly moving towards the north and is expected to be north of the Sister Islands later tonight. This noted improvement is in line with model guidance and gives confidence to improvement expected for tomorrow.

## **Forecast Conditions:**

**This evening:** Cloudy to overcast skies with moderate showers and thunder are expected mainly over the Sister Islands through late tonight. A further decrease in cloudiness and showers is expected from late tonight across the Cayman Islands.

Further rainfall accumulations are expected to be limited with a chance isolated maximum of near 0.5-1 inch projected mainly over the Sister Islands lasting through late tonight.

Winds will be southeast to south at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts in and around heavy thunders. Seas will be rough with wave heights of 4 to 6 feet. **Small craft should exercise caution over the open seas.** 

**Tomorrow:** Partly cloudy skies with a 30% chance of showers.
