## **CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY**

Her Excellency the Governor Mrs. Jane Owen, chaired the meeting of the Cabinet held on Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

Mr. Jason Webster acted as Cabinet Secretary. All Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- Confirmed approval granted by circulation on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2023 for the issuance of a conditional exemption from gainful occupation requirements for non-Caymanian pursuant to section 53(1)(b) of the Immigration (Transition) Act (2022 Revision);
- Refused an application for the issuance of a Coastal Works Permit to dredge an access channel offshore Block 20C Parcel 176;
- Approved:
  - The purchase of Block 14CJ Parcel 25; and
  - In accordance with sections 11 (5) and (6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2020 Revision) to decrease TP 67 – Sports and Cultural Tourism Programmes by \$150,000 and increase EA 4 – Land Purchases in the Ministry of District Administration and Lands by \$150,000;
- Approved the Ministry of Youth, Sports, Culture and Heritage to establish and administer a wider public consultation for the selection of the Cayman Islands National Dress, Dance, Drink, Dish and Dessert;
- Approved the Development and Planning (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 and its onward submission to Parliament;
- Approved in accordance with Legal Practitioners (Student) Regulations (2018 Revision) the application for a non-Caymanian to be permitted to register articles of clerkship;
- Approved in accordance with sections 11(5) and 11(6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2020 Revision) to decrease EA 161 – Submarine Cable by \$1,150,000 and increase EI 12 – Ministry of Education by \$1,150,000 to facilitate the resolution of the issues with air conditioning at the Clifton Hunter High School; and
- Noted update on the Cayman Home Energy Efficiency Retrofit (CHEER) Programme.
