



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

Her Excellency the Governor Mrs. Jane Owen, chaired the meeting of the Cabinet held on Tuesday, 30th January 2024 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

All Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- Approved the (38) 2024 law revisions and authorised their publication in accordance with section 4 of the Law Revision Act (2020 Revision);
- Approved for the George Town Primary School to be re-named the Sharon (Marie) Martin Primary School;
- Approved the renewal of a lease of a storage unit for the Passport Office;
- Approved the renewal of two boat slip agreements for the Department of Environment;
- Approved the purchase of land being Block 106E Parcel 47;
- Noted the Annual Reports for the Ministry of Home Affairs for Financial Years ending 31st December 2021 and 31st December 2022 and authorised for the Annual Reports to be presented to Parliament;
- Noted the Utility Regulation and Competition Office 2022 Annual Report and authorised for the Annual Report to be presented to Parliament;
- Approved the appointment of the following persons as Notaries Public in accordance with Notaries Public Act (2023 Revision): Morgan Bodden, Dane Campbell, Cashema Clarke, O'Brian Clarke, Brandon Esteban, Selina Tibbetts, Adriana Turner, and Shaneil Whittaker;
- Relating to the Trade and Business Licensing Board:
 - Accepted the resignation of Paul Rivers as Member;
 - Approved the appointment of Reginald Delapenha as a Member; and
 - Approved the re-appointment of Michelle Coleman and Brian Barnes as Members;
- Approved exemption from Planning Permission under section 53 of the Development and Planning Act (2021 Revision) for the construction of an 8-foot-tall chain-link fence on Block 20E Parcel 356 and for use of the area as a new secure storage and impound lot for the RCIPS.
